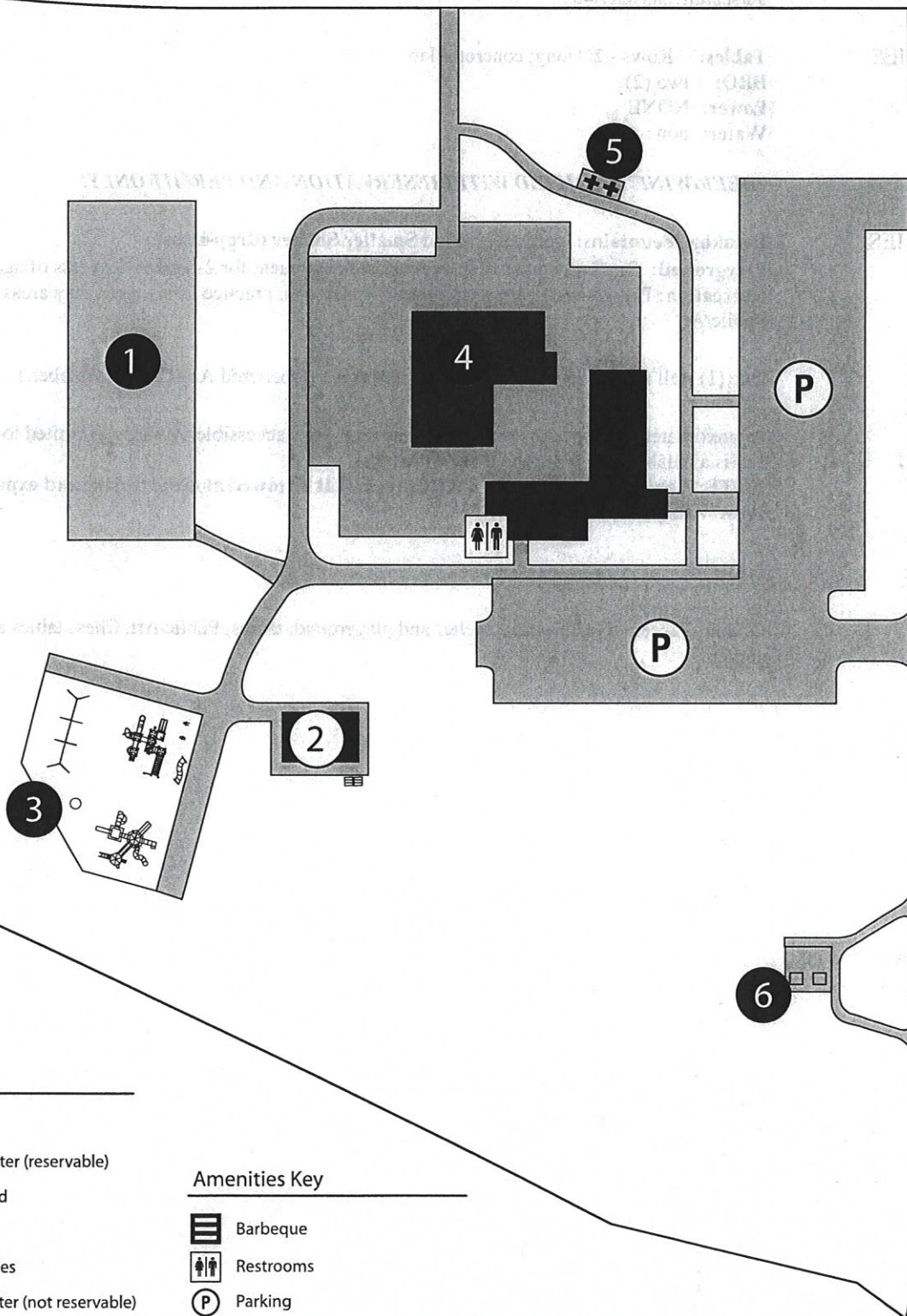

**BORAH PARK**  
**801 S. Aurora Dr**  
(19.6 Acre Community Park)

Borah Park is a community park located in southwest Boise. It can be accessed via Cassia Street South of Overland Road, Right on South Curtis, Left on Cassia Street, Left of Aurora Drive.

**RESERVABLE:** Shelter 30'x45' (larger shelter)

**CAPACITY:** 50/seating capacity 48

**PICNIC FACILITIES:** **Tables:** 2 Rows - 24' long; concrete slab.

**BBQ:** two (2)

**Power:** NONE

**Water:** none

**Drinking Fountains:** near playground **Smaller Shelter (drop-in use)**

**Playground:** Southwest of shelter; appropriate equipment for 2-5 and 5-12 years of age, swing set

**Recreation:** Playground, Pool and Community Garden, practice fields, open play areas, chess tables and Public Art.

**RESTROOMS:** One (1) stall for women and One (1) stall for men. (Open mid April to mid October.)

**PARKING:** Approximately 74 spaces (Three (3) of these are ADA accessible. Parking is limited to designated areas and is available on a first come first serve basis.

**NOTE: Vehicles parked in NO PARK areas will be towed at owner's risk and expense.**
